

First U.S. 2022 Scholarship Guidelines

The following guidelines will apply to the application and awarding of two (2) \$1,000 existing member scholarships: one to a current high school student bound for college in the fall of 2022, and one for a student currently enrolled at a college, university or career college that will be enrolled to continue in the fall of 2022.

Eligibility Requirements

The applicant must:

- 1. Be a First U.S. member in good standing
- 2. Be a graduating high school student or continuing college student
- 3. Maintain a GPA of at least 3.0 (on 4.0 scale)

Application Requirements

- 1. A completed Scholarship Application
- 2. A personal statement essay answering the following questions: (750 words or less)
 - a. What life experiences or achievements have helped you get to this point in life?
 - b. What are your extra-curricular activities? What types of leadership positions have you held?
 - c. What is your intended academic curriculum?
 - d. How will you maximize the opportunities of higher education?
 - e. How will you apply what you have learned to your post-college plans and aspirations?
- 3. An un-opened, certified transcript

Award Criteria

- 1. Acceptance into a community college, career college or four-year college or university for the 2022-2023 academic year
- 2. Full-time enrollment of 12 or more credits or units
- 3. Applications will be reviewed by a committee and the scholarships will be awarded based on these categories:
 - A. GPA
 - B. Essay content
 - C. Financial need (see application)

Timelines

- 1. Scholarship Applications will be available at any First U.S. Branch location or at firstus.org.
- 2. Completed applications must be received at the credit union by close of business on Wednesday, August 31, 2022
- 3. Scholarships will be awarded after September 30, 2022. After confirmation of registration and acceptance at school, award checks will be made out to the college or the award recipient

IMPORTANT INFORMATION BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Applications must be received at First U.S. Community Credit Union by August 31, 2022. You must be a member of First U.S. as of the date that you submit the application as a graduating high school senior or currently enrolled college student in the 2022-2023 school year. Applications will not be returned and will become the property of First U.S. First U.S. officers, employees and their families are not eligible. The winning entries will be chosen at the discretion of First U.S. staff. Illegible entries may be disqualified. Winners will be notified after September 30, 2022, by mail or phone and agree to have their names and photos published in First U.S. promotional materials. After confirmation of registration and/or acceptance at a two-year community college or a four-year college or university with 12 or more credits or units in classes, award checks will be issued to the award recipient or their school. Not valid where prohibited by law.

- 1. A personal statement essay (in 750 words or less) answering the following questions:
 - a. What life experiences or achievements have helped you get to this point in life?
 - b. What are your extra-curricular activities? What types of leadership positions have you held?
 - c. What is your intended academic curriculum?
 - d. How will you maximize the opportunities of higher education?
 - e. How will you apply what you have learned to your post-college plans and aspirations?
